Client overview

Den Hartogh Logistics is a leading logistic services provider for the petrochemical industry. This family business, established in 1920, carries out more than 150,000 bulk gas and chemical transport carriages per year all over the world. It also operates 5 tank cleaning stations within Europe. Den Hartogh Logistics has 30 branch offices, a staff of 1,000 and a sales turnover of EUR 200 million.

Transaction overview

Den Hartogh Logistics sold its storage terminal activities in Moerdijk, to Stolt-Nielsen Limited, the listed global provider of integrated transportation solutions for bulk liquid chemicals and other specialty liquids.

The storage terminal for bulk liquid chemicals consists of 30 stainless steel tanks with a total capacity of 17,720 cbm. The facility includes a drumming operation, three warehouses, a jetty with a draft of 8.4 meters and a tank container storage depot.

The sale is consistent with Den Hartogh's strategy to deliver maximum value to its customers in the core activities in which Den Hartogh is operating. The cash proceeds of the sale will be allocated to fund Den Hartogh's global growth strategy.
