Vega Engenharia e Consultoria Ltda is the Brazilian leader in engineering services for railway infrastructures focused on freight transportation. Vega also performs infrastructure projects in urban environments and highways for both private and public sector clients. It is a private company with EUR 18 million in annual sales located in Curitiba.

Egis, with its French counterpart Iosis, is on its way to becoming the indisputable leader in infrastructure engineering. CDC (Caisse des dépôts et consignations) owns 80% of the group and management owns the remaining 20%. The group will have EUR 815 million in consolidated sales.

Demand in rail infrastructure continues to grow. With its acquisition of Vega, Egis takes advantage of specific expertise locally and exports it abroad while bringing its own added value in urban transportation.

Situation overview

Clairfield International solicited potential buyers all over the world and Vega received several indications of interest.
