Hogeschool Windesheim, one of the largest Dutch universities of applied sciences, acquired four schools from the Hogeschool van Amsterdam in Almere.

The transaction was the first step in Windesheim's plan to found a new higher education institution in the province of Flevoland, aiming to eventually reach 6000 students.

Clairfield Partners in the Netherlands (Boer & Croon) advised Hogeschool Windesheim on the business plan, arranged the necessary financing (EUR 72 million) from various government bodies, and acted as financial advisors to Windesheim.
